

FAJITA COOK-OFF



SATURDAY, MAY 4 | 12 - 6 p.m. | WOLF PEN CREEK FESTIVAL SITE

It's time to fire up your grill and prove you are a fajita aficionado at the Wolf Pen Creek Festival Site Grand-Opening **Fajita Cook-Off** on Saturday, May 4. The Cook-Off will be divided into two categories, commercial and non-commercial, with prizes being awarded to 1st-3rd places in both divisions.

As part of the Grand-Opening Celebration, the entire family can enjoy entertainment, a petting zoo, bounce houses, vendors and the fiercest cooking competition this side of the Rio Grande. When the competition is over, you're invited to the Wolf Pen Creek Amphitheater for the opening night of the Starlight Music Series with Del Castillo and Texas A&M graduate and country music recording artist Rick Treviño headlining on-stage entertainment.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Contest is limited to the first 30 entries. Entry deadline is 5 p.m., Friday, April 19, 2013. Contestant set-up will be from 8-11 a.m. on May 4. All contestants must be set-up by 11 a.m.

2. Entry fee is \$20 per team site and payment is required with the entry form. Payment includes a 10 x 10 space. All equipment/decorations must fit within. Additional space may be purchased for \$15. Spaces will be pre-assigned according to the order of entries.

3. Make all checks payable to: CITY OF COLLEGE STATION

4. Plug-in (110/220 volt) electrical equipment allowed. No generators. Propane is allowed in a self-contained unit (camping stove, grill, etc.). No open fires or ground pits are allowed. All teams must provide a fire extinguisher. Please monitor the sound levels of audio equipment in respect to your fellow cooks. Violations are subject to DISQUALIFICATION WITH NO REFUND.

5. No vehicles in camp will be allowed in or out during competition hours of 11-5 p.m. Violations are subject to DISQUALIFICATION WITH NO REFUND. Plenty of parking will be available in designated Cook-Off contestant parking that you will receive prior to the contest.

6. Cook-Off contestants must provide meat, barbecue pit, utensils, supplies, etc. No glass.

7. Mechanical tenderizing is NOT allowed. Prior marinating of fajitas is allowed but no commercial marinating. Actual cooking must be done on location.

8. Commercial and non-commercial teams must consist of a head cook who is responsible for the operation of the team space and all actions within or outside of the designated space by members or guests of their cooking team. All head cooks must be 18 years of age or older.

9. Judging categories and criteria:

A. Commercial - Taste and tenderness

B. Non-commercial - Taste and tenderness

10. Fajitas are required to be ready for judging by 4 p.m. on May 4. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

11. Award ceremony will take place at 7 p.m. on the Wolf Pen Creek Amphitheater Stage. Visa gift cards and aprons will be awarded to 1st-3rd place in both divisions.

12. No provisions are made by the promoter for disposal of excess food products. Removal is the responsibility of the head cook or her/his designee. Site is required to be clean by 7 p.m. on May 4.

RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT FOR ADULTS

This release shall apply regardless of whether said claims, demands, and causes of action are covered in whole or in part by insurance and regardless of whether such injury, death, loss, or damage was caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the City, any other party released hereunder, the Participant, or any third party.
